Dual Enrollment Options are courses that are available for **current Roosevelt High School juniors and seniors** to take that provide both high school credit towards graduation, as well as college credit. Roosevelt High School partners with AIMS Community College and the University of Northern Colorado to provide a variety of options. For each course, the student is responsible for purchasing the required book and materials.

*Applicants must complete a 500 word leadership essay.

*Must receive a minimum of one reference.

*Possess strong moral and ethical standards.

*Current Physical.

*Perform well on the Initial Strength Test. *An IST is not required for selection, but will be considered if submitted as part of the application.

*While athletics, leadership positions and service-oriented activities are not required, they are important to the overall selection process.

*Participation in Reserve Officer Training Corps programs is not required.
